THE GIFT OF A MOMENT

A testimony from Silvia Viola, CLC Italy

It was a quiet afternoon in our Torino bookshop when she walked in — a woman unlike most of our usual visitors. Her long dreadlocks framed a thoughtful face; her presence felt grounded yet searching. She came straight to the counter and asked for something small, “A simple book about God,” she said.

“It’s for my father,” she explained. “He’s in the hospital. He never believed in God — not once in his life. But lately, I’ve seen him reading the Bible. I don’t know if it’s faith or just something to pass the time, but I want to help him find some peace.”

I led her to a little book that had brought comfort to many over the years: *Peace with God – The Secret of Happiness* by Billy Graham. She took one look and said, “Yes. This is it.”

With that book in hand, something inside her opened. She told me about her own spiritual journey, that she was Buddhist but deeply open. “I believe in something bigger,” she said, “and I think truth shows up in many ways.”

As she wandered through the shop, she began marveling over the children’s section. She was a teacher, she told me, and always on the lookout for good material. Her Catholic colleagues had been kind to her and she wanted to give them something they would appreciate.

She chose calendars with daily verses and little devotionals for kids. Before long, her arms were full.

As she came to the counter with her purchases, I felt a quiet nudge in my spirit — one I’ve learned not to ignore. I excused myself and walked to the back room, returning with a gift copy of *Death of a Guru*.

I returned just in time to hear her say, “You know... I love giving gifts to people. I really do. But sometimes it’s hard. I hardly ever get anything in return.”

In the perfect silence that followed, I held out the book and said, “Then this is for you. Since you’re always giving to others, today you get to receive. I hope that through the spirituality you seek, this book will speak to your heart — with the love and truth of Jesus.”

She froze. Her eyes welled with tears. “Really? For me?” When I nodded, something inside her broke free. She burst into tears, clutching the book to her chest. Unable to speak, she whispered a soft thank you, then hurried out the door, overwhelmed by the unexplainable beauty of it all.

Hours later, she came back — radiant. She had run into an old friend on the street, someone she hadn’t seen in years. Right there, outside the shop. “I had to bring her in,” she said. “This place... it’s full of something special.”

She picked out a calendar for her friend and hugged me, full of warmth and gratitude.

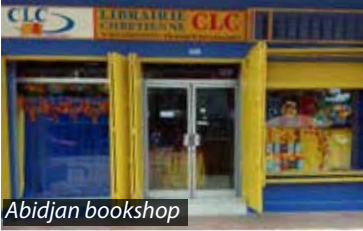
“I’ll be praying for you,” I said.

She looked at me, nodded, and smiled.

We never know how God will work through a conversation, a small book, or a passing moment. But when we listen and offer what little we have in love, we become part of something eternal.

In Myanmar, hope feels like a distant memory.

Following a devastating combination of political unrest, a global pandemic, and a powerful 7.7 magnitude earthquake, many in this nation have been left feeling broken, fearful, and uncertain of the future. Families are grieving, communities are struggling, and it seems as though darkness has settled over the land.

Yet in the midst of despair, **God's Word remains a beacon of hope.**

At CLC, our mission is to honour God by making Christian literature and resources available to all nations so that people everywhere can come to faith and maturity in the Lord Jesus Christ. In Myanmar, we are stepping into this mission with urgency and prayerful determination.

Jacob Mung, National Director of CLC Myanmar, is leading an initiative to bring the life-changing message of the Gospel to his people through the **distribution of Burmese Bibles.**

The Vision: Reaching Hearts Through the Word of God

Despite having over 100 ethnic groups and dialects, Burmese remains the official and most widely understood language in Myanmar, which is why our team is focusing their efforts on making Scripture available in Burmese, the language of

schools, government, and media.

This Bible project includes two crucial components:

- **Printing 20,000 standard Burmese Bibles**
 - **Reprinting 10,000 copies of the Myanmar Study Bible**, the *first-ever* non-denominational Study Bible in Burmese.
- These Bibles are more than just books; they are the **living Word of God**, the only lasting source of peace and purpose for people surrounded by uncertainty.
- We are trusting God to allow printing to begin this year, with a major logistical effort to ship the Bibles into Myanmar via Thailand in 2026. With border restrictions, economic struggles, customs challenges, and transport costs, this will be one of the

most complex operations CLC Myanmar has undertaken.

The economic crisis in Myanmar means that raising funds locally is nearly impossible, yet the need has never been greater. **90% of the population still hasn't heard the Gospel.** This is a spiritual emergency.

island of Cyprus—a place where sunshine meets spiritual hunger.

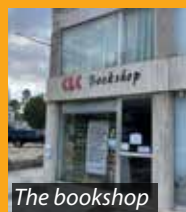

PROJECT UPDATE

CLC - ELS Chennai Building Project

Partner with us to complete a God-given vision in India.

Our team in India is in the final stages of one of their most ambitious projects to date: the construction of a brand-new ministry building in **Chennai, Tamil Nadu**, which began as a vision born out of both necessity and faith.

In 2016, after more than 65 years of ministry in the same rented building, our team at Evangelical Literature Service (ELS) Purasawalkam was asked to vacate the premises. It was a moment of uncertainty, but also of opportunity. The Lord stirred a thought in the heart of the National Director, **Justin Chellappan**: *What if we build our own space?*

By God's provision, a vacant lot previously gifted by ELS's founder was identified as the perfect location and in 2023 the construction began—by faith—despite not having full funding in place.

Today, we're almost there.

This **four-storey** building will serve as a powerful hub for Christian outreach in a country where 74.3% of the population practices Hinduism. The facility will include:

- A large 222 m² Christian bookstore and showroom
- Conference rooms for discipleship and ministry training
- Guest accommodations for visiting pastors, missionaries, and partners
- Ground-floor parking and other essential infrastructure.

Not only will this building allow us to expand our mission, but it will significantly

reduce rental expenses, freeing up funds to further the work of ELS across India.

But to finish the work, **we need your help.**

Construction from the ground up brings many challenges and unexpected costs. With your support, we can complete this project by the end of 2025 and provide a lasting foundation for ministry in one of the world's most spiritually needy regions.

Bibles for Young Hearts: CLC Children's Bible Project

While visiting CLC's bookshop in Chiang Mai, Thailand, I quickly realized that only a handful of children's Bibles were available in the Thai language.

This led to the launch of the CLC Children's Bible Project, with a clear goal: to provide affordable, age-appropriate Bibles for children in countries where such resources are scarce or unaffordable.

Children are naturally open to the Gospel—but only if they can access it in a way they understand. The project focuses on countries with small evangelical populations and limited printing resources, including Benin, Bulgaria, Burkina Faso, India, Ivory Coast, Kenya, Mozambique, Myanmar, Pakistan, Portugal, and Thailand.

The project offers Bibles appropriate for three key age groups:

- Ages 3–5: Vivid illustrations and simple storytelling.



- Ages 6–10: Captivating illustrations with more detailed stories for young readers.

- Ages 11+: Full-colour Bibles of about 250 pages, with deeper biblical content—often appreciated by adults as well.

Our vision is for each CLC country to have quantities of at least three different Bibles—one for each age group—available in their national language.

Phase 1 saw 8,000 copies of *The Picture Bible* (for ages 5–10) distributed in India, Kenya, the Philippines, and Uganda.

Phase 2 included 2,000 devotional Bibles

printed for children in the Philippines and 15,000 more for various age groups in Bulgaria, India, Italy, Mozambique, Myanmar, Poland, Romania, and Thailand. French-language Bibles are also being distributed in Benin, Burkina Faso, and Ivory Coast in West Africa.

Phase 3 aims to translate and print 25,000 copies of *God's Colorful Kingdom Storybook Bible* (Tyndale), which features 31 Bible stories. Our goal is to make it available by mid-2026 in 12 languages for children aged 10–14 across 15 countries, including Ukraine.

Will you help CLC print at least 50,000 Children's Bibles—or even 100,000, as the Lord provides?

Each Bible costs \$2.50 to \$4.50 to print, excluding shipping. Every copy can impact entire families, as parents and grandparents often read along.

July 28th - August 3rd

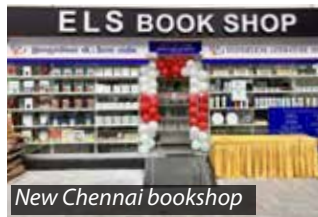
Week 31 - Asia
